



Accessing your superannuation

If you are leaving Australia permanently and not returning, you can claim your superannuation money when you get home.

How do you do this?

Before you depart Australia, start preparing your documents and begin your application to access your superannuation through the Departing Australia Superannuation Payment (DASP) system. This will make it easier to lodge your claim when you return home.
